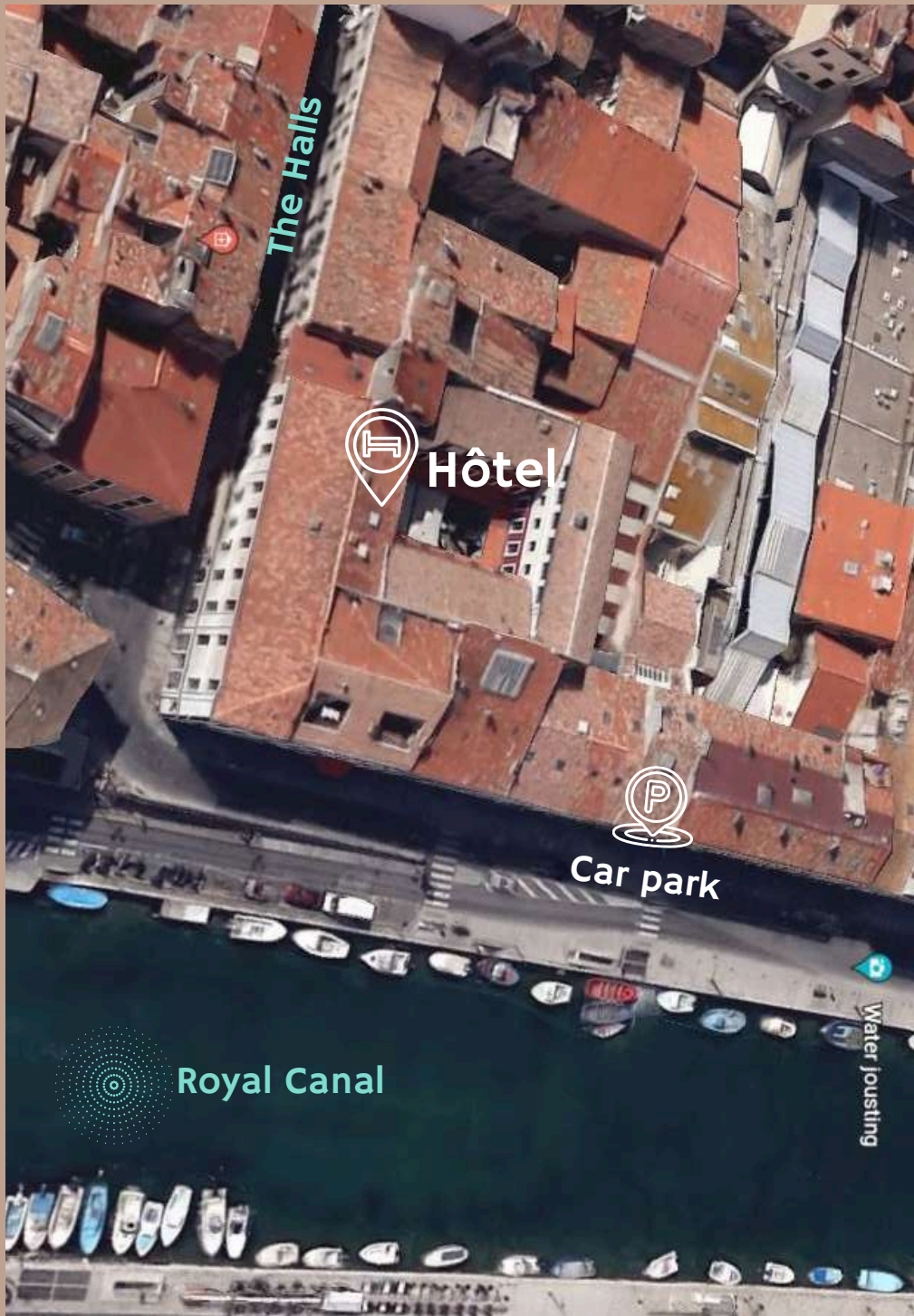

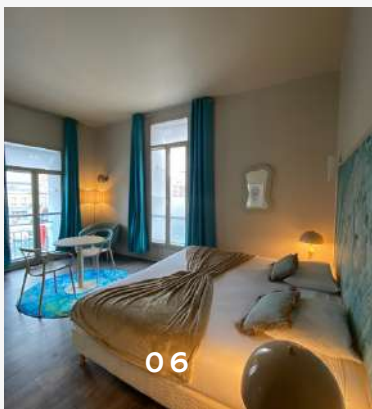


Comfort and a friendly atmosphere, but above all attention and kindness, this is what emanates from the spirit of the 36 rooms of the Hôtel de Paris.

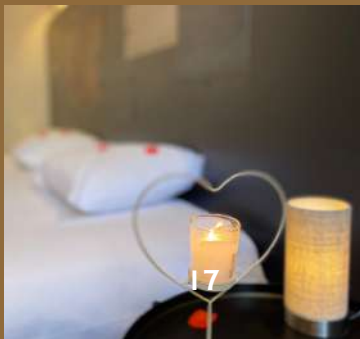

THE HISTORY

OF THE HOTEL DE PARIS

A beautiful history inscribed in the walls

Since its construction in the 17th century, the Hôtel de Paris, previously known as the Hôtel du Grand Galion, has always been a strong symbol of the city of Sète.

Imposing because of its size and location, it was at the time a place of reference as an inn and later hosted luxurious banquets during which meetings between the city's administrative and economic authorities took place.

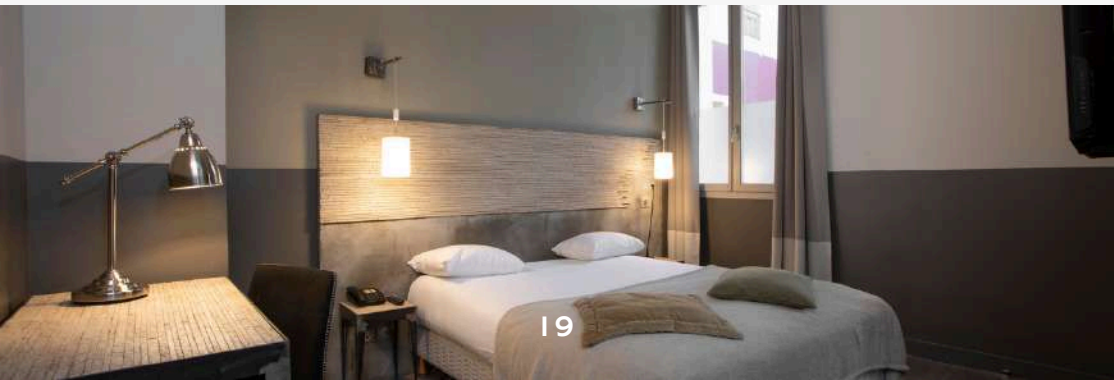
In the 1920s, the Aguillon family acquired the Hôtel de Paris, where baptisms, communions and weddings were regularly held.

Today, the Ganivenq family runs the establishment, which has since been completely restored.

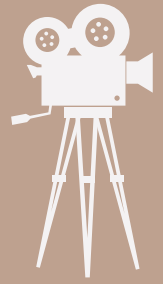
At the heart of the patio was a plane tree with which desks and wooden tables were built. As for the decoration of the rooms, it was carried out according to the 5 themes on which the project is based: concrete, wood, metal, stone, earth and artist's studio.

The rooms and suites offer a pleasant view of the patio, the canal, the roofs of the city or the pedestrian street.

The combination of all these ingredients creates a very special atmosphere in the hotel.



SUCCESS SERIES & CINEMA ENGINE RUNS!



DEMAIN NOUS APPARTIENT

Since February 2017, the former bottling site of the Skalli wine company has been transformed into a film studio of more than 7,000 m2 and a room at 6 quai Aspirant Herber into the café "Le Spoon", today the official shop of the series.

With an episode broadcast every evening, from Monday to Friday, the series Demain nous appartient was quickly adopted. You will find its natural settings as you stroll along the canals, near the school, at the beach...

Much more than a simple viewer, come and stroll along the emblematic filming locations that you will find every evening on TF1

From culture to anecdotes, follow the tracks of the series "Demain nous appartient" through the streets of Sète.

SÈTE AT THE CINEMA

The unique light of Sète captivated the world of cinema very early on. Between 1937 with Jean Gabin in Julien Duvivier's "Pépé le Moko" and 2016 with Catherine Deneuve and Diane Kruger in Thierry Klifa's "Tout nous sépare", more than 60 feature films have been shot there.

Lino Ventura, Brigitte Bardot, Philippe Noiret, Alain Delon, Yves Montand, Romy Schneider, Samy Fray, Gérard Depardieu, Nathalie Baye, Audrey Tautou, Catherine Frot, Richard Berry, Patrick Bruel, Richard Anconina... are among the impressive list of actors who have come to Sète.

DISCOVER

IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF GEORGES BRASSENS

The artist Georges Brassens grew up in a working-class neighbourhood in the port of Sète. He spent a happy childhood there, lulled by songs and sunshine, between friends, walks and freedom.

Today, the house where Brassens was born has not changed. It is still occupied by the family. Only the name of the street has changed: rue de l'Hospice has been renamed "Rue Brassens".

STREET ART A SÈTE

Sète is a great playground in this field. Every year, the city hosts the "K-Live" festival dedicated to urban arts and music. Thus, a real open-air museum has been installed on the city walls over the years.

LE THÉÂTRE MOLIÈRE

Listed as a historical monument since 2003 and recognised as "the most beautiful Italian-style theatre in the south of France

"the most beautiful Italian-style theatre in the South of France", the Molière Theatre lives all year round to the rhythm of the performance season. More than 40 performances in theatre, dance, song, classical or contemporary music, lyrical art or contemporary circus, take place there.

LE THÉÂTRE DE LA MER

Formerly devoted solely to theatre, under the name of Théâtre Jean Vilar, the Théâtre de la Mer in Sète now hosts numerous concerts, shows and festivals throughout the summer.

This open-air theatre, located on a cliff facing the sea, allows the public to admire the artist and the horizon at the same time.

THE MUST-SEE VISITS

Stroll through the town centre of Sète, discover the viewpoint of Mont Saint-Clair or the Pierres Blanches, visit the Georges Brassens space, the marine cemetery, the marina and the Môle Saint-Louis, the beaches of Sète...

OUR TRADITIONAL FESTIVALS

Escale à Sète is the largest maritime festival organised in the Mediterranean. It takes place every two years in the port of Sète. For several days, the largest and most beautiful traditional boats call at Sète and are open to visitors.

In August, during one week, the Saint Louis festival offers spectacular jousting tournaments!

IT HAS BECOME A SÈTOISE TRADITION



SAINT LOUIS

Celebrated at the end of August, Saint-Louis is the patron saint's day of Sète and the biggest event of the year since the port was founded in 1666. For six days, the city vibrates to the rhythm of water jousting, notably with the Grand Prix de la Saint-Louis, the final tournament for jousts. To the sound of oboes and drums, the white knights of the tintaine compete on jousting boats, trying to knock each other off with their lances while protecting themselves with shields. The competition culminates with the clash of the "heavyweights," bringing the festivities to a close. Beyond being a sport recognized since 1960, water jousting is a tradition inseparable from Sète's identity, celebrated in a festive atmosphere where lively streets and quayside bars contribute to the popular fervor.

A FESTIVAL OF FESTIVALS

- Fiest'A Sète brings the city to life with sounds from around the world, offering a musical journey with mixed influences on the shores of the Mediterranean.
- Jazz à Sète brings together the biggest names in jazz every year in the exceptional setting of the Théâtre de la Mer, facing the sunset.
- Demi Festival, created by rapper Demi Portion, celebrates independent rap in an authentic and friendly atmosphere.
- Worldwide Festival, initiated by Gilles Peterson, offers an eclectic program mixing electro, soul, and funk against a backdrop of beaches and festive nights.
- Quand je pense à Fernande celebrates French song with humor, poetry, and a tribute to Georges Brassens.
- ImageSingulières is a must-see event for documentary photography enthusiasts, exhibiting striking works throughout the city.
- K-Live Festival combines street art and music, transforming Sète into an open-air museum with monumental murals.
- Voix Vives brings Mediterranean poetry to life in the narrow streets of Sète, offering readings, meetings, and artistic performances.
- Les Automn'Halles celebrates literature through meetings with authors and fascinating literary debates.
- Le BAZR ends the year on a high note with a festival combining music, arts, and a creators' market in a festive and offbeat atmosphere

NOS MARCHÉS

Every Wednesday, a large open-air market surrounds the covered market and attracts crowds from across the region as well as numerous tourists.

A vast meeting place, the square has become a lively spot where café terraces are always bustling at aperitif time, even in winter!

In addition to the indoor market in Les Halles, Sète's open-air markets bring the town center to life on Wednesdays and Fridays.

On Wednesdays, it takes place in the pedestrianized heart of the town, mainly on Rue Gambetta and Rue Alsace-Lorraine, before moving to Rue Victor Hugo on Fridays.

À DÉCOUVRIR

Cuttlefish rouille:

With its fragrant tomato sauce, enhanced by a delicious aioli, cuttlefish rouille is ideal for a delicious meal with family or friends, enjoyed on a summer terrace or, when winter comes, to rediscover some of the flavors of sunny cuisine.

Stuffed squid:

Stuffed squid, accompanied by a delicious, slowly simmered tomato sauce, can be enjoyed with the family alongside spaghetti or white rice.

Stuffed mussels:

Stuffed mussels were often prepared in Sète households for Sunday family meals.

Macaronade:

A dish with a distinctly Italian influence. Pasta, beef, sausage, tomato... Fishermen could certainly set out to sea with a full stomach.

Tielles:

This generous octopus pie, imported from Italy at the end of the 19th century, has become the culinary emblem of the city over time.

CULTURE & HERITAGE

Sète, a town of character between the sea and the lagoon, reveals a rich heritage and vibrant culture through its iconic sites. From the top of the Belvédère de Saint-Clair, the panoramic view takes in the Mediterranean and the rooftops of Sète, while the Pierres Blanches national forest offers a green setting perfect for a stroll. In the Upper Quarter, the Notre-Dame-de-la-Salette Chapel stands out with its colorful frescoes and intimate atmosphere. Below, the Cadre Royal, with its canals lined with boats and lively bridges, is the beating heart of the city and the scene of the famous water jousting tournaments. The Théâtre de la Mer, a former military fortress converted into an open-air stage, hosts festivals and concerts in a spectacular setting facing the sea. Alongside the port, the Saint-Louis lighthouse has guided sailors for centuries and marks the entrance to the Môle, a long pier where walkers come to admire the horizon. Finally, the picturesque Pointe Courte district, with its fishermen's huts and authentic atmosphere, is a reminder of the unbreakable link between Sète and its maritime identity.
